

Emergency Humanitarian Relief Program-

Various need-based service projects were initiated under the leadership of **President Rtn. Raja Ram Phuyal** in collaboration with 13 Rotary Clubs and other stakeholders, collectively working under the name **Rotary Action Group** during the recent Gen -Z protest .The partner clubs included: Rotary Club of Gongabu, Rotary Club of Kathmandu, Rotary Club of Kathmandu Circle, Rotary Club of Matribhumi Baluwatar, Rotary Club of Balaju, Rotary Club of Kathmandu Height, Rotary Club of Bagmati Kathmandu, Rotary Club of Patan, Rotary Club of Kathmandu Downtown, Rotary Club of Rajdhani, Rotary Club of Madhyapur Thimi, Rotary Club of Kathmandu Metro, and Rotary Club of Tinkune Kathmandu.

The initiatives carried out were as follows:

1.Blood Donation Program-

2. Medical Assistance to the Injured

- Assisted in transporting the injured to Civil Hospital, Teaching Hospital, and Green City Hospital for immediate treatment.
- Treasurer of RC Gongabu, **Rtn. Chandra Kanta Wagle**, was actively engaged from the very beginning, helping those in need.
- Successfully facilitated free-of-cost operations for two injured patients at Teaching Hospital, which had initially denied the request.

3. Support for Patients and Medical Teams

- Provided food and snacks to injured individuals, as well as nurses and guards on duty at the Trauma Centre.

- Helped reconnect injured protesters with their families, arranged personal vehicles to take them home post-treatment, and supported ambulance expenses when required.
- Supplied food, water, masks, and gloves to medical teams deployed for security and treatment.

4. Support to Basundhara Police Station

- Donated a water tank worth NPR 75,000.
- Formed a committee for the reconstruction of destroyed structures at Basundhara Police Station.
- Collected more funds than initially required, and reconstruction work will commence soon.

5. Support to Thapathali Police Station

- Organized a cleaning program at Thapathali Traffic Police Station.
- Provided snacks and cash support to the staff.
- Donated **15 sets of mattresses, blankets, pillows, bed sheets**, and other essential assistance.
- Further support has been pledged as needed

6. Support to Dharmasthali Police Station, Tarkeshwor Municipality

- Donated **three computers and one printer**.
- Committed to constructing toilets, with work already underway.
- Allocated a budget of NPR 600,000 for the toilet construction project.

7. We, the Rotary Club of Gongabu joined hand with the 12 other clubs to complete the project of restoring drinking water plant project at Bagghikhana, Traffic Police Station within 3 days under the leadership Rtn Sanjay Agrawal, president of Rotary Club of Kathmandu with the support and guidance of the Rotary International District 3292 Nepal-Bhutan
